Obligatory Written Assignment: Do one of the following assignments:

Create a Film Poster for Your Book: Imagine that your book is about to be remade into a movie. Create a film poster that shows something significant about the plot, tone, and/or theme of the story in such a way that it will attract a big audience. What famous actors would have the leading roles? Who would direct it? One thing I hate about film adaptions is how they differ from the book. What has your film got right? Where is it different from the book? On the back of your poster, you should include a fictional review from someone like Roger Ebert or a newspaper like *The Guardian*.

OR

Get Crafty with Cartography): Look back closely at the places that were important in your book, and illustrate a map that shows where they all are in relation to one another. Then create a legend/key in which you explain why each place is so important to the story (2-3 sentences for each item on the map). This works well with books in which the location is really important, like Steve Sheinkin's book <u>Bomb</u>. Select this project if you pay close attention to detail.
